Experience: We are looking for individuals with experience of working with children and young people. You will need a sound understanding of the practical, emotional, social and economic issues children affected by domestic abuse. You will need a thorough knowledge of the Children's Act, child protection and safeguarding for children and adults. You will be patient, understanding, calm and reassuring and be able to help children and young people understands their needs, assess the risks they face and support them in developing safety plans. You will also have experience working with multiple agencies to ensure the children's voices are heard and their needs and views are represented and met.
